

#### WHERE ARE OUR EMERGENCY SHELTER LOCATIONS?

Over a dozen emergency shelter locations are pre-identified and evaluated as potential shelter locations in and around OC, however, WHICH site will be used cannot be identified until after the height of the storm has passed.

Sites need to be evaluated to ensure they are not damaged themselves, have power in order to support the needs of the shelter and finally that the roads to the site are accessible to the public (ie; no downed trees or washed out bridges prohibiting the public from getting to the shelter location).

There are also limited resources (blankets, cots, and volunteers to run a shelter) in OC for which to open a shelter. With this in mind the harder hit areas or more densely populated areas will most likely have a Red Cross shelter opened in their area.

Please help get the word out, 911 is for LIFE-SAFETY ISSUES ONLY! While we recognize that it is a major inconvenience if it is not a life-safety issues please dial 211 for information.

OCEM has been updated by all utility companies that the preliminary damage assessment has been completed and they are hoping to be able to report municipality specific power restoration times by tomorrow...that is good news!

NYS currently has 2 million customers without power. Orange County currently has 60,000 - it is inconvenient <u>but we are by no means as bad as the rest of the state.</u>

Orange County has had no fatalities, major roads are open, gas stations and grocery stations accessible, hospitals servicing people, schools re-opening and reestablishing a sense of normalcy ...we are ok!

Please stay calm, keep our inconvenience in perspective in light of the magnitude of this storm and the damage it has caused and where we are in relation to those around us.

#### ARE WE UNDER A STATE OF EMERGENCY

OCEM often is asked if the County is in a 'State of Emergency' (SOE). In simple terms a SOE means that conditions have deteriorated so significantly that in order to save lives or mitigate property damage, the County must operate beyond the normal scope of our authority. In short, we need to 'side-step' local laws in order to safety and effectively respond to the emergency.

An example of some of these laws might include (but are not limited to); restricting travel, issuing curfews, limiting water usage, or obtaining a minimum of three bids from vendors before purchasing emergency response equipment.

The legal document which allows this 'TEMPORARY' action is Executive Article 2-B. In order to read more about this document, please visit the link provided below.
