


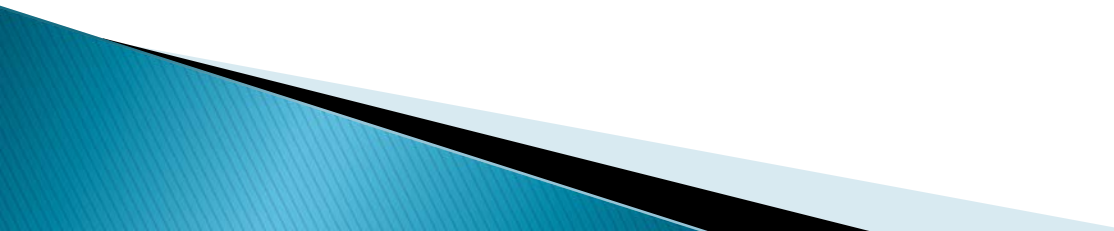

LEGISLATIVE REPORT
2015

Assembly – 8138/Senate 5987

- ▶ Sponsor – Magee
 - ▶ 1/27/14– Referred to Governmental Operations
 - ▶ Establishes a supplemental state disaster aid program within the NYS emergency assistance program to aid municipalities, residents and businesses that have been otherwise denied assistance from the federal government.

Assembly –1612


- ▶ Sponsor – Magee
 - ▶ 1 /12 /15 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
 - ▶ Amends the state finance law and executive law to establish and administer a supplemental state disaster aid program when federal assistance is unavailable.
- 

Assembly Bill – 6194

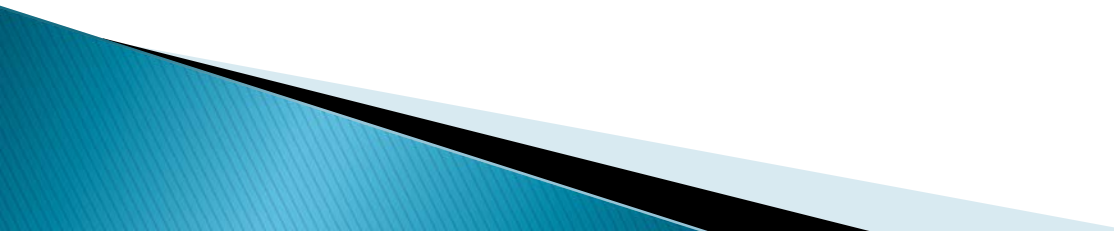
Assembly – 6432 / Senate – 4759 (7257 – 2012)

- ▶ Sponsor – Tedisco
- ▶ 1 / 8 / 14 – Referred to Governmental Operations
- ▶ Adds Elderly persons to disaster registries and creates a state emergency assistance database; provides that the Disaster Preparedness Commission (DPC) shall establish the database.

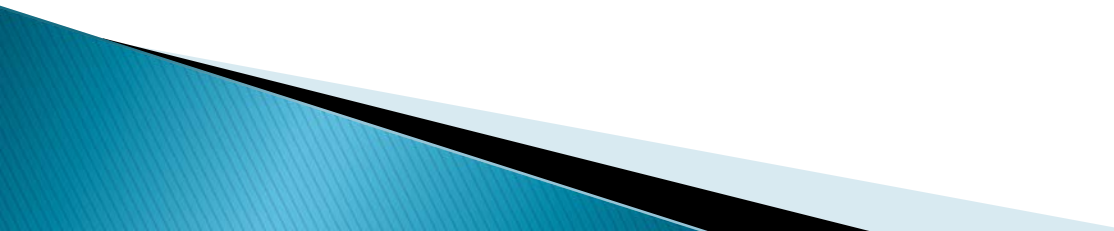
Assembly – 1741

- ▶ Sponsor – Tedisco
 - ▶ 1/12/15 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
 - ▶ Amends executive law; creates a state emergency assistance database (DPC responsible) *Requires, rather than authorizes, county governments to maintain a registry of disabled persons, to include elderly persons.

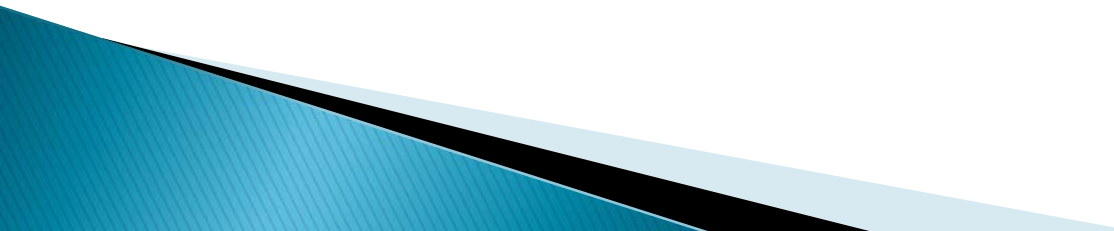
Assembly – 2200 / Senate 2244

- ▶ Sponsor – Weprin
 - ▶ 1 / 15 / 15 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
 - ▶ Establishes an emergency evacuation plan for individuals with disabilities, who live in a high-rise building, establishes a \$500 fine for failure to comply.


Assembly – 2335

- ▶ Sponsor – Crouch
 - ▶ 1 / 16 / 15 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
 - ▶ Establishes a fire prevention and emergency taskforce to develop a plan for training requirements and standards for fire prevention and emergency response services in rural areas.
- 

Assembly – 3175 / Senate – 2169 (6532A – 2014)

- ▶ Sponsor – Rosenthal
 - ▶ 1 / 22 / 15 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
 - ▶ Establishes “emergency preparedness month act: and exempts pre-fabricated go-bags and individual emergency preparedness items from sales tax during specified time periods.
- 

Assembly – 4145

- ▶ Sponsor – Kearns
 - ▶ 1 / 29 / 15 – Referred to Ways and Means
 - ▶ Provides a credit for general volunteer services performed and hours expended during a federal disaster or emergency.
