LEGISLATIVE REPORT
2017



Assembly – 1741 (2016)

- Sponsor – Tedisco
- 1/6/16 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- 5/23/16 – Held for Consideration in Gov't Ops.
- Amends executive law; creates a state emergency assistance database (DPC responsible) *Requires, rather than authorizes, county governments to maintain a registry of disabled persons, to include elderly persons.

Assembly - 4484

- Sponsor – Magee
- 2/2/17 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- Amends State Finance Law to provide for prompt payment requirements of storm relief and recovery aid to counties, cities, towns, villages and school districts.

Assembly - 4556 (same as 8651 in 2016)

- Sponsor – Kearns
- 2/3/17 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- Authorizes chief executives to designate any vehicle as an emergency vehicle during a declaration of a disaster emergency.

Assembly – 1741

- Sponsor – Skoufis
- 1/12/17 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- Enacts the “Natural Disaster Preparedness and Mitigation Act” providing for enhanced disaster preparedness and recovery from disasters.

Assembly 1817

- Sponsor – Crouch
- 1/13/17 – Referred to Environmental Conservation
- Authorizes and directs the Commissioner of DEC to establish a Stream Maintenance and Flood Control Program that counties may opt into.

Assembly – 2215

- Sponsor – Crouch
- 1/17/17 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- Establishes a fire prevention and emergency task force to develop a plan for training requirements and standards for fire prevention and emergency response services in rural areas.

Assembly - 2218

- Sponsor – Ortiz
- 1/17/17 – Referred to cities
- Authorizes and directs certain cities to conduct a study on the preparedness and readiness of such city to react and respond to certain disasters.

Assembly - 3214

- Sponsor – Ortiz
- 1/27/17 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- Requires local disaster preparedness plans to include a public education component as part of disaster prevention.

Assembly - 4196

- Sponsor – Magee
- 2/1/17 – Referred to Gov't Ops.
- Establishes a supplemental state disaster aid program within the NYS emergency assistance program to aid municipalities, residents and businesses that have been otherwise denied assistance from the federal government.
