
Strategic Thinking and Planning

Strategic Thinking

Definition:

Is a process that defines the manner in which people think about, assess, view, and create the future for themselves and others.

Strategic Planning

Definition:

Strategic planning is an organization's process of defining its strategy, or direction, and making decisions on allocating resources to pursue this strategy.

It may also extend to control mechanisms for guiding the implementation of the strategy.
