

## Dickinson (Tx.) Police Department 10 Incidents that require the initiation of the Incident Command System.

- Severe weather incident (Hurricanes Floods)
- Evacuations
- ► Major roadway closures
- ▶ Officer Involved shootings
- ► Mass Causality Incident (>3)
- Missing person that requires search
- Suspicions object or package
- ► Complex crime scene
- ► Hazardous Materials Incidents
- ► Planned Events (>4 officers)
