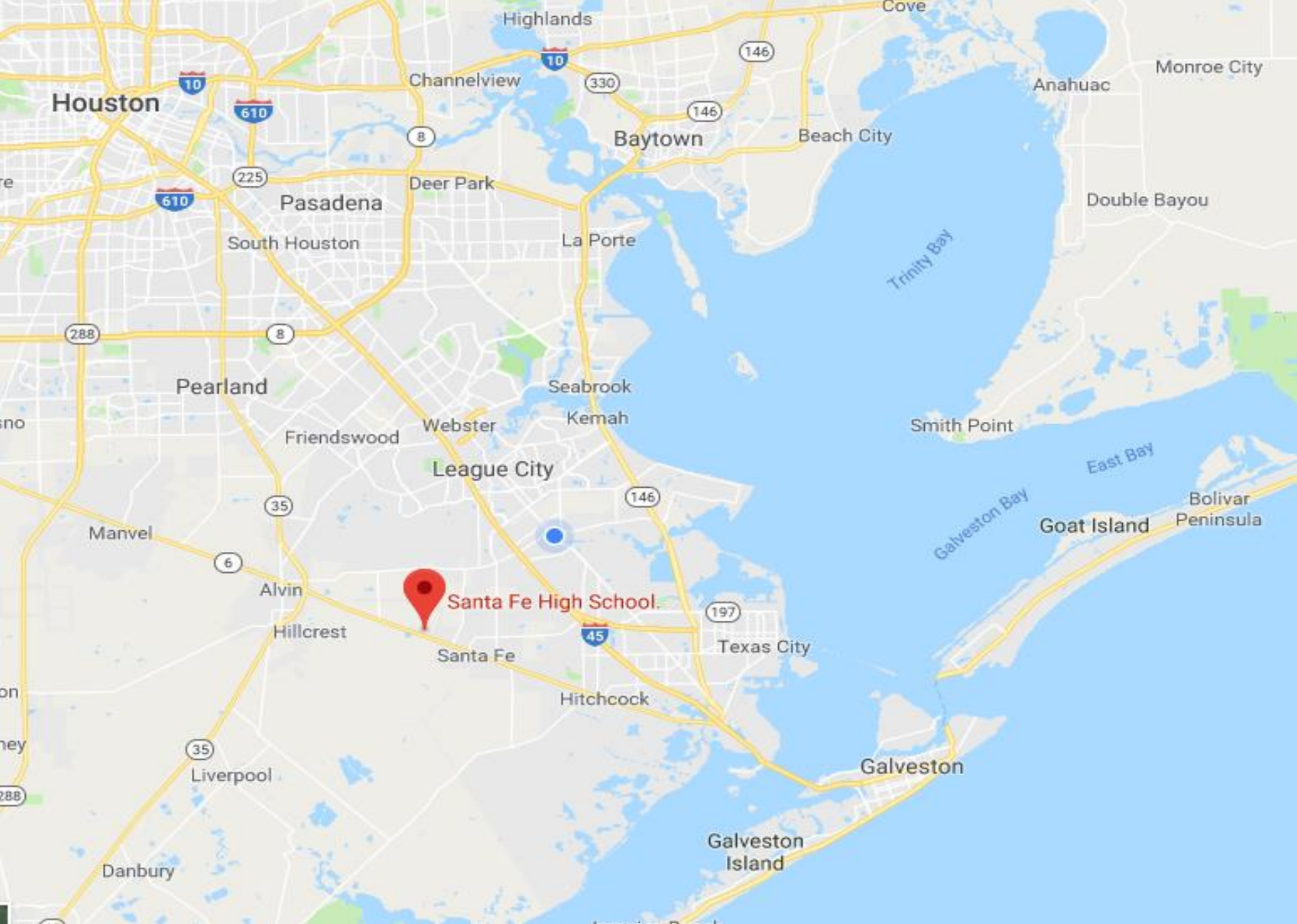

10 Incidents that require the initiation of the Incident Command System.

- ▶ Severe weather incident (Hurricanes – Floods)
- ▶ Evacuations
- ▶ Major roadway closures
- ▶ Officer Involved shootings
- ▶ Mass Causality Incident (>3)
- ▶ Missing person that requires search
- ▶ Suspicious object or package
- ▶ Complex crime scene
- ▶ Hazardous Materials Incidents
- ▶ Planned Events (>4 officers)

L = Life Safety

I = Incident Stabilization

P = Property Preservation

S = Society Restoration

M – Mission Support

A - Authority

P - Policy

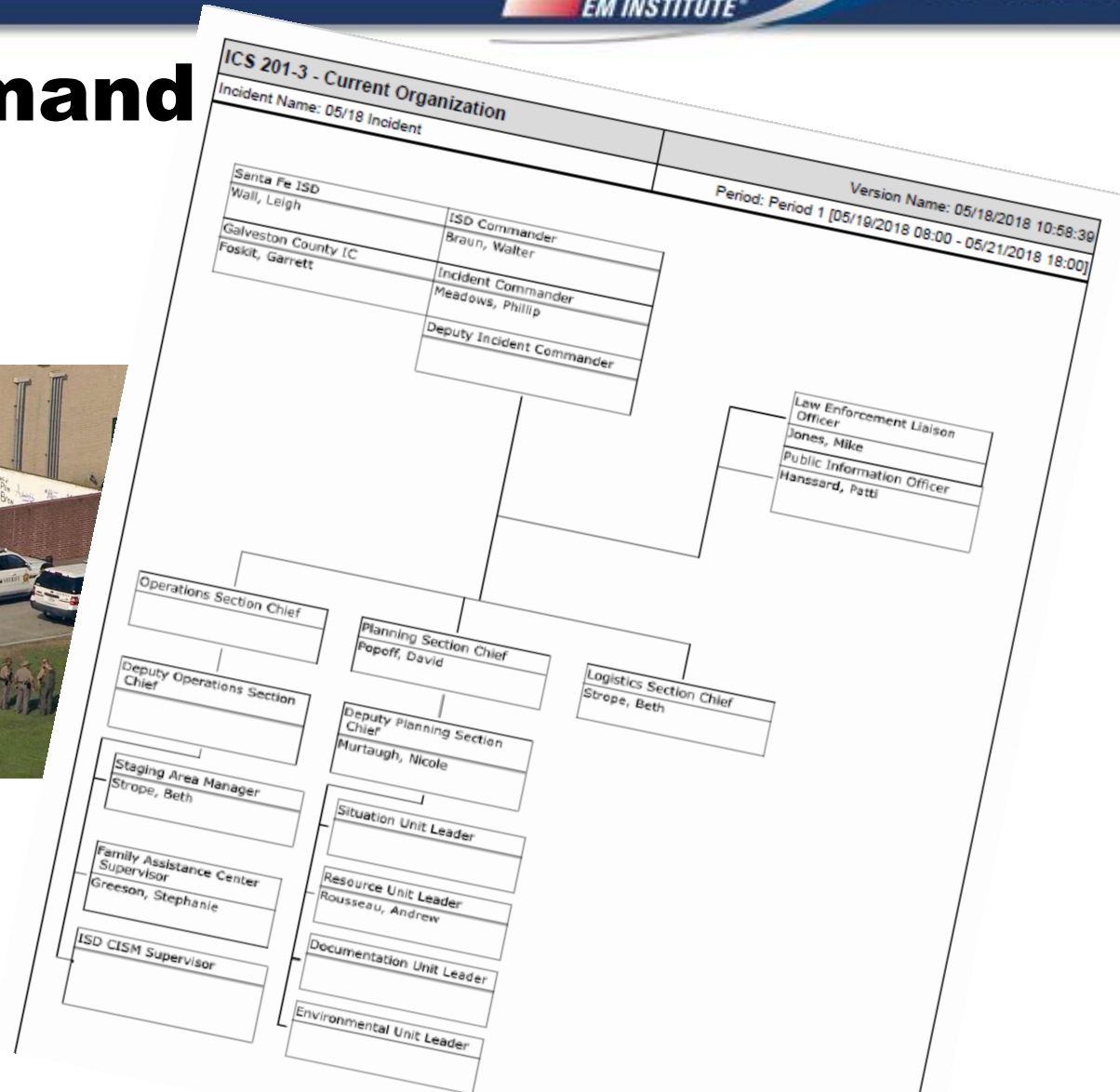

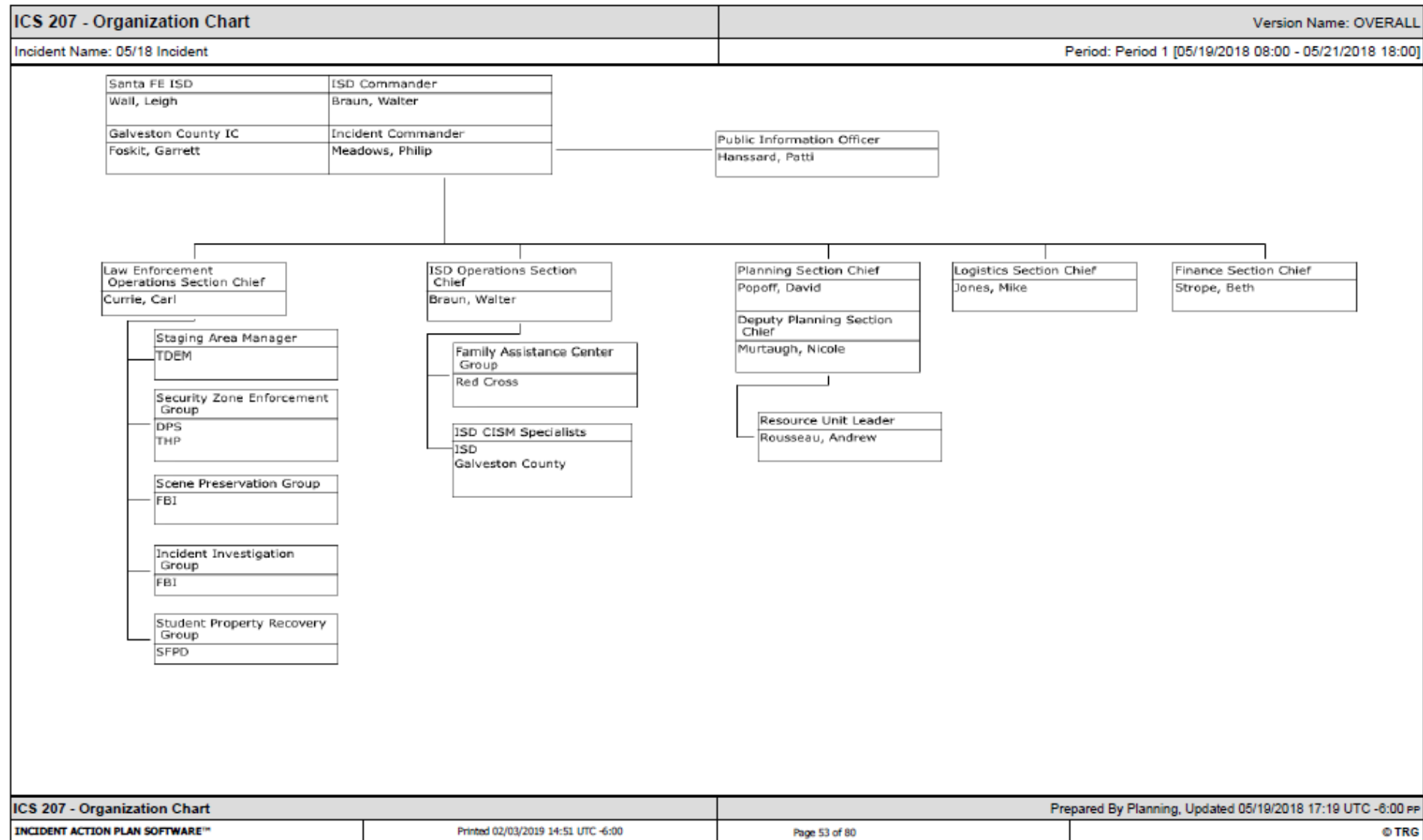

Set up road blocks to establish a controlled perimeter around school property. The following road blocks are to deny entry and exit to the school				
1. Three (3) North back entrances to the High School off 1st Street. (Sites 1, 2, and 3)				
2. The southeast entrance off of Highway 6 closest to Morning Glory Drive. (Site 4)				
The Main Gate Roadblock off Highway 6 at the traffic light will allow access to response personnel only. Response personnel must show proper identification for all personnel in the vehicle to be granted entry.				
The Media Gate Roadblock off Highway 6 will grant access media outlets with issued press badges.				
A Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) is in place from 10:00 05/19 to 10:00 05/20. If media is observed using aerial equipment, inform them of the TFR.

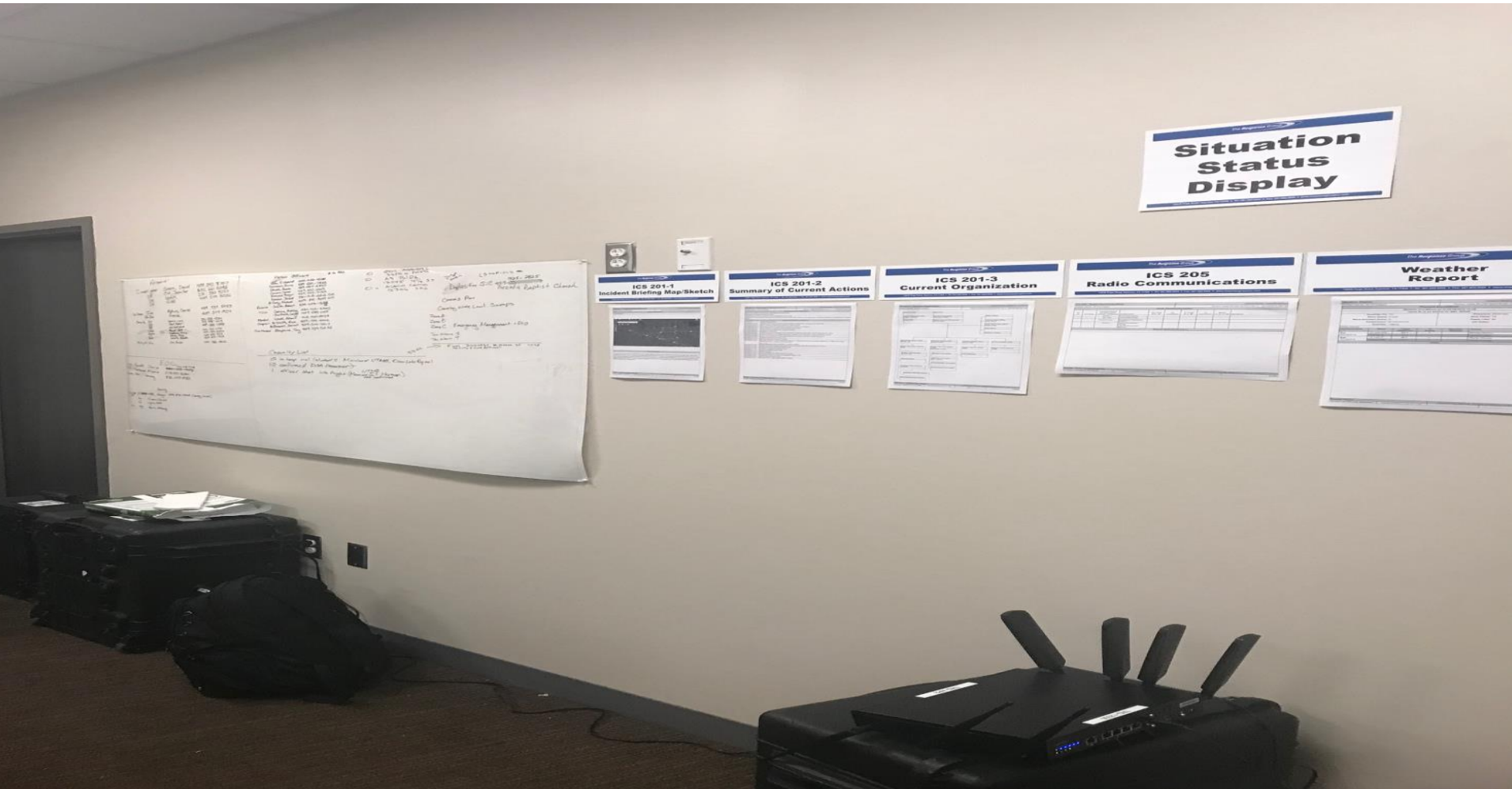
